RECORD TRAFFIC FOR TORINO AIRPORT:

- Best year ever with 4.19 million passengers in 2022
- Best week ever with 103 thousand passengers from 2 to 8 January 2023
 - Best day ever with 20 thousand passengers on 8 January 2023

Caselle Torinese, 17 January 2023 - Torino Airport recorded its **all-time traffic record in 2022**, with **4,193,881 million passengers** choosing the airport for their journeys. This breaks the previous record of 2017 (4,176,556 passengers), despite the first months of 2022 still being negatively impacted by the Omicron variant of Covid-19.

This result, with a growth rate above the national average, was achieved thanks to the opening of the Ryanair base in November 2021: **during 2022, the carrier carried more than 2 million passengers**.

In 2022, the first destination served in terms of traffic volume was **Catania**, followed by **Naples** and **Bari**.

London was the first among international destinations followed by Paris and Barcelona.

Passengers more than doubled compared to 2021 and exceeded even those of 2019, the last pre-Covid year. Indeed, 2022 saw an increase of +103% compared to the 2,066,106 passengers in 2021 and +6% compared to the 3,952,158 passengers in 2019.

The new year opened under the banner of snow tourism-related traffic, with a range of destinations served by scheduled and charter flights to Northern Europe and Great Britain.

The success of this market segment, which is very important for the region's tourism development, contributed to **the airport breaking two other absolute records** already in the first days of 2023: with **103,555 passengers, the week from 2 to 8 January 2023** was the busiest ever; with **19,955 passengers, Sunday 8 January 2023** set a daily record.
