

**TORINO AIRPORT ANNOUNCES THE LAUNCH
OF THREE NEW FLIGHTS TO STOCKHOLM, VILNIUS
AND MANCHESTER OPERATED BY RYANAIR**

Caselle Torinese, June, 7 2022 – Torino Airport announces the launch of three new routes to Stockholm, Sweden, Vilnius, Lithuania, and Manchester, Great Britain, to be operated by Ryanair starting with the 2022/2023 winter season.

The connection to/from Stockholm will operate from November 2, 2022, with two weekly frequencies (Wednesday and Saturday); the flight to/from Manchester will operate from November 5, 2022, with one weekly frequency (Saturday); finally, the route to/from Vilnius will operate from December 1, 2022, with two weekly frequencies (Thursday and Sunday).

The three new routes are already available on the airline's sales channels, with fares starting at €19.99 (one way).

Torino Airport CEO Andrea Andorno commented: "We are very pleased that Ryanair has decided to start the three new routes to Stockholm, Manchester and Vilnius with the upcoming winter season. In addition to expanding the network of flights over Great Britain, we are also adding two European capitals in two nations not served directly from Turin until now. This is an important confirmation of Ryanair's commitment to our airport, also in view of the results achieved so far. Thanks to really affordable fares, our territory will thus have wider mobility possibilities than ever before, with new visitors also coming from countries hitherto not connected with Turin and Piedmont."
