

RYANAIR LAUNCHES WINTER '24 SCHEDULE IN TURIN 3 NEW ROUTES, 2 AIRCRAFT (\$200M INVESTMENT) AND AN INCREASE IN TRAFFIC UP TO 2.4 MILLION PASSENGERS PER YEAR

Ryanair, Italy's No. 1 airline, today (11 November) launched its 2024 winter schedule in Turin, with 30 routes, including 3 new routes to Crotone, Reggio Calabria and Salerno Costa d'Amalfi, as well as increased frequencies on over 10 existing routes that are very popular such as Barcelona, Brussels and London Stansted.

Ryanair's winter 2024 schedule will operate with the airline's 2 Turin-based aircraft, representing a \$200 million investment, which in turn supports over 1,800 jobs, as well as promoting year-round inbound tourism in Turin and the region.

Ryanair's W24 operation in Turin includes:

- 2 aircraft- \$200 million investment.
- 30 routes, including 3 new ones to Crotone, Reggio Calabria and Salerno.
- Increased frequency on more than 10 existing routes, including Barcelona, Brussels and London Stansted
- 2.4 million passengers per year.
- Over 1,800 jobs.

Ryanair has been operating flights to/from Turin for 25 years and has so far carried over 17 million passengers: the company aims to continue investing and growing traffic in Piedmont and throughout Italy. To continue to generate this growth and support tourism, Ryanair is calling on the Italian government and regional authorities to eliminate municipal addition in all Italian airports. This will allow Ryanair and other airlines to quickly offer new routes, tourism and jobs throughout the year.

To celebrate the 2024 winter schedule and the 3 new routes to/from Turin, Ryanair has launched a 3-day promotion with fares starting from just €19.99, available from today for booking only on ryanair.com.

Fabrizio Francioni, Head of Communications Italy at Ryanair, said:

"As Italy's No. 1 airline, Ryanair is pleased to announce the 2024 winter schedule in Turin with 30 routes, including 3 new routes to Crotone, Reggio Calabria and Salerno Costa d'Amalfi, over 280 weekly flights and increased traffic to 2.4 million passengers per year. Numbers that highlight Ryanair's commitment to the development of Piedmont.

We have been operating flights to/from Turin for 25 years, during which time we have invested significant sums in the region, including 2 aircraft based in Turin (representing an investment of \$200 million), supporting over 1,800 jobs, increasing inbound tourism and improving connectivity for Turin residents."

Paolo Papale, Director of Aviation Development at Torino Airport commented:

"We are happy to celebrate 25 years of Ryanair operating at our airport. The role of the airline has strengthened over time to the point of making Turin its base 3 years ago: since then, the passengers carried by Ryanair have increased year on year, contributing significantly to the overall growth of the airport. The increase in frequencies has been continuous, ensuring greater connectivity to our territory both to new international markets and to national destinations not previously connected".
